

If/then clauses:

If past tense verb, then conditional tense verb.

If Misato **had** a flying car, (then) she **would have fun** in the clouds.

Examples of conditional verbs – modals: might, could, would, should, may, ought to

If present tense verb, then conditional, future, or present tense verb.

If Misato **has** a flying car, then she **could have** fun in the clouds.

If Misato **has** a flying car, then she **will have** fun in the clouds.

If Misato **has** a flying car, then she **has** fun in the clouds.

If future tense verb, then conditional or future tense verb.

If Misato **will get** a flying car, then she **could have** fun in the clouds.

If Misato **will get** a flying car, then she **will have** fun in the clouds.
